Rev Dr Stewart Weaver noted in an Ascend article in 2023 how, during Covid, he began reading through the Book of Common Order, lingering on some of the Daily Devotional prayers & savouring lines like

'Keep us, this day and every day, in the spirit of kindness, simplicity and joy.'

'In the new creation, your grace has dawned upon the world with healing for all.'




Shetland Church of Scotland comprises 12 local congregations spread out over a number of church buildings. There are three ministers covering the different geographical areas of the islands.
