Item 6. Table. Approx. 1.2m x 0.75m (4' x 2'6"). It's had a hard life but it's solid!



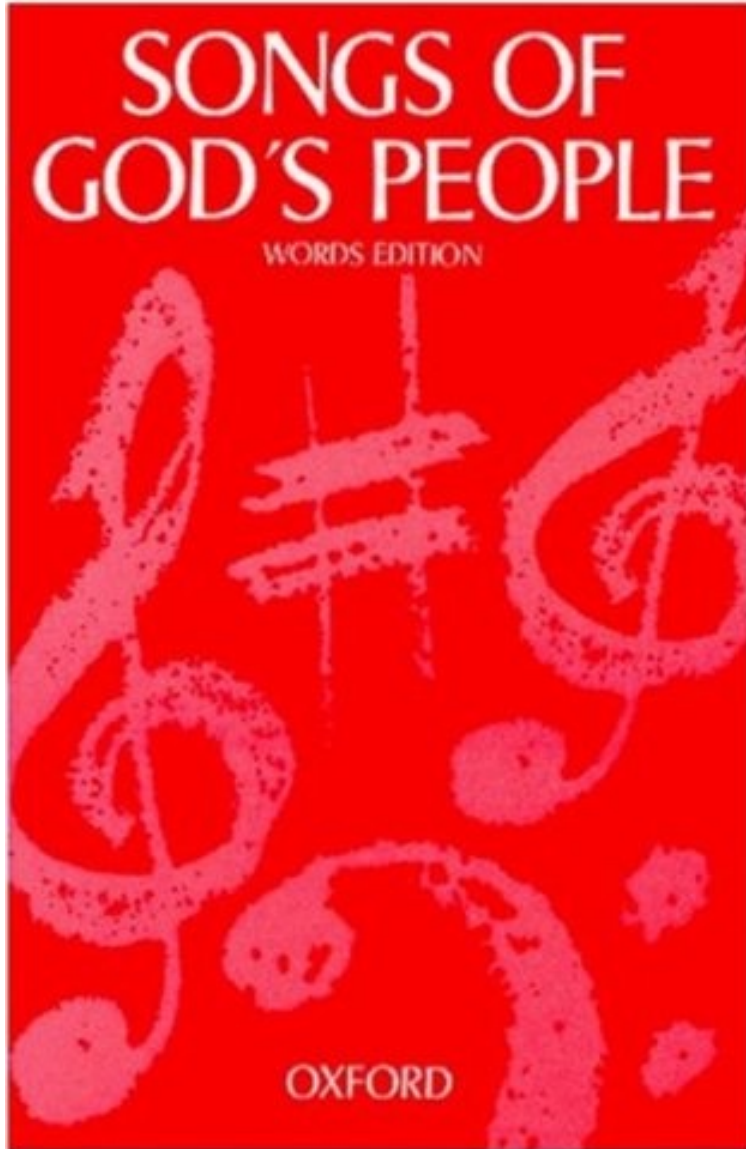
Item 7. UNICOL equipment trolley. The top is black, it's just reflecting lights in the photo. We used it for a PC, monitor, keyboard and mouse.



Item 8. A/V Cabinet. We had a mixing board and small PC on the top part and raised the lid during use. The cabinet held a DVD/CD player, an amp, an induction loop driver, and a couple of wireless mic receivers. None of that equipment is included, just the cabinet 😊



Item 9. "Songs of God's People, words edition". Because of unions, we've three churches' copies of these, so however many you want we can probably accommodate 😊



Item 10. Ricoh Priort Digital Duplicator.

We've a Ricoh Priort DX3240 digital duplicator (sometimes called a Mimeograph or Gestetner machine) that we no longer need. It's well specified, manages better than 90 copies a minute, collates, staples, and does A3 as well as A4. There's some consumables, we'll include a pack of A4 and A3 paper to practice with, and we'll provide training in how it works when you come to collect it. The manual is available on the Ricoh website. It's on castors but it's a heavy awkward beast to move, so bringing some roughly-toughy helpers to shift it would be a good plan. Note: this isn't a computer printer, it's more like a photocopier on steroids.
