



TEAMWORK? THE STRUGGLE TO GET FREE?

Not for the first time, I asked the Lord what on earth we are supposed to do with the plagues



in Exodus 7-12. I got no answer.

But I did notice, for the first time unbelievably, that although Aaron was specifically 'recruited' to be Moses' mouth-piece, he actually does none of the speaking to the Pharaoh.

But he does take over the use of the **staff to** perform the first 3 miracles/ plagues. [Ex 7:19; 8: 8, 16] Twice, Moses only speaks a **word** - flies & diseased animals [Ex 8:21-24; 9: 1-3].

Once, they both go with ashes in their hand. But only Moses throws them in the air - boils [Ex 9: 8-10]. Only Moses is mentioned for the hailstones, locusts and darkness [Ex 9: 23-24; 10: 12-13 & 21]. The last and most terrible 'plague', the death of all the firstborn, was entirely of the Lord. All Moses, Aaron and the people did was prepare as instructed and wait under the 'covering' of the blood of lambs



splashed on the doorposts



of their homes while the Angel of the Lord 'passed over' them. What on earth are we to make of all this horror, Lord? I still don't know! But I see leaders working on their own and with others under God's instruction and finally the Lord acting alone in salvation power. I also see how horrendously messy and frightening is the process to make God's individual people into one united people, and to set them free from the slavery of past attitudes, thoughts and attachments.

Is this what the Church of Scotland is going through at this time? As frightened and hurt as some may be by what we are witnessing and experiencing in church circles and in the wider world, we can rest '*safe and secure from all alarms*' under the protection of our God who cares for us with extravagant love and does the ultimate hard thing for us - sheds his blood and dies to set us free.

Lord, to be honest, we still don't understand it. But we're glad that you do the hard yards for us. We hide ourselves in Jesus and trust you for the 'salvation' of the Church of Scotland and our world. We pray for all the charges noted below, especially for any finding it particularly hard or frustrating to effect the change necessary to move on. We pray for tired Ministers, Interim Moderators and office bearers, especially any who have fallen ill. In your mercy, revive, heal and strengthen all in need of your touch. We also rejoice with those who have been less affected by major change and are working well in their new circumstances. Keep them humble and mindful of any neighbours they might be able to help in some way. In Jesus' name. Amen.




