This local group is available to record the contents of both closing and active vibrant churches. We approach churches directly, often when we have a contact within the church or community. We then send details of what we will survey and how we will carry it out. The survey consists of measuring, describing and photographing - following a format devised by Scotland's Churches Trust.

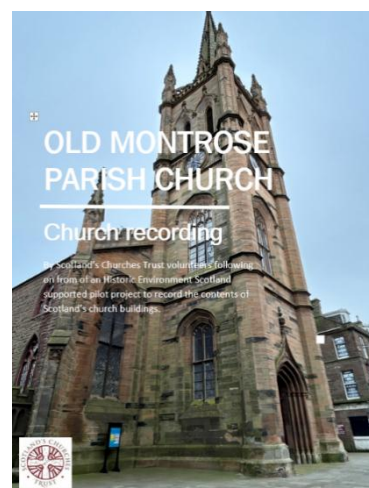


Our group agree a date and attend the church. We especially like to chat with congregation members if they are available as they contribute greatly to the social history of the church (Banchory East St Ternans, left).

We produce a report (front cover of Old Montrose, right) which includes a history of the church and memories of parishioners.

The contents of the church are recorded in a digital database - the church can have a copy of this. The report is agreed by the Church, SCT Director Dr DJ Johnston-Smith and the volunteers. Plate and silver items are never recorded in the report.

Our volunteers are friendly and above all careful with all objects handled.
