With thanks to funding from the National Lottery Community Fund "Awards for All", The Caim Project, part of Howe o' the Mearns Parish Church of Scotland, wish to recruit for a new position of Growing Coordinator, to work with our Project Lead to oversee, develop and maintain the growing of produce (both on open fields and in polytunnels) and biodiversity work on our 2.5-acre site in Luthermuir. As well as the produce growing, this role will also support our all age group of volunteers, and liaise with the Project Lead on developing our existing schools link work.

This 2-year funded role will initially be for 12 hours a week, to be worked flexibly as agreed, but subject to further funding, has the potential to be extended and expanded.
