REMISSIONING COLLECTIVES

Since 2022, Remissioning Collectives have been serving leaders leading the renewal of their church on mission with God.

COACHING COHORTS

Over 25 weeks, leaders are coached in small groups by experienced practitioners on weekly video calls. This includes an immersive in-person intensive together, hosted in one of our Coaches' home communities.

THE PATHWAY

Leaders follow a Jesus-shaped pathway integrating theology, character, practices and transferable tools; building their own Remissioning Roadmap with their church.

OUTCOMES

Leaders grow in clarity, competence, confidence, and good company; while leading their church into greater missional faithfulness and fruitfulness.

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CURRICULUM + COACHING

Our curriculum is born out of practice, developed by diverse coaches in diverse contexts: published theologians, intercultural missionaries, institutional pastors, bi-vocational church planters and more. Theologically rich and Christ-focussed; as concerned with the soul of a Leader as with the systems and strategy of a Church. We speak multiple languages and draw from the wisdom of the Church around the world.

Our coaches are live practitioners, actively engaged in leading the hard and beautiful work of renewal in their own places over years, as well as learning and serving nationally and internationally in Network, Denominational and Movement roles.

The result is a formational gift of transferable tools and robust theology facilitated by skilled guides who understand the work we're called to, the reality of doing it with real people — and who we're called to become in the midst of it.

Funding Support

Funding your training is flexible. We offer deposit options and instalments, as well as supporting you to find relevant funding from your Denomination or Network. Where possible, we recommend that your church contribute what they can, because it helps them be invested in the journey as a reflection that a Remissioning Collective goes beyond focussed support for exceptional leaders to empower the whole church on mission.

Time and Dates | September 2026 - April 2027

The weekly, hour-long Coaching Calls for Collectives are set by each Collective themselves, ensuring a regular time and day that works for everyone. Breaks are taken over universal holidays.

Intensive | January 28 - 30th 2027, Upper Braes Parish Church, Falkirk

As well as the weekly Zoom calls, we host an in-person gathering over 2 days for all the Collective participants starting that term.

We get to know one another, learn in the context of a church doing its own Remissioning work, and eat together.

We believe that the work of Remissioning is deeply relational, and we can't do this work together well without knowing each other better.

The intensive is included in the registration cost. While we're together, we cover all group meals. Your travel and accommodation is up to you.

Registration Deadline

Collective registrations for September 2026 need to be confirmed by the end of July 2026 with at least a deposit.
